- **Astronaut Eileen Ochoa, KB5TZZ** has been named the 11th director of the Johnson Space Center in Houston, Texas.

- Meeting location the agreement with the church is up for renewal. The club agrees to renew for the next 6 months, regardless of possible increase.
- Elections no one steps forward for the President, Vice-President or Treasurer positions. Election is held and Gary is re-elected President, Don is re-elected Treasurer and Jay is elected Secretary. The office of Vice-President is currently in limbo, with Doc being listed as VP pending future situations.

Discussion regarding purchase of a 400W wind powered generator for QRP Field Day. Board approved purchase to begin plans for mounting, etc. Cost: approx \$400.

Louie WB8WXS has been asked to approach the airport management to secure access to an area just west of Helmer Road. This area is fenced but free of obstructions and is more readily visible to the public. Jay will approach Meijer's management regarding access to the old Meijer property on Columbia for use also.

The board also discussed the need to monitor the 2m repeater during Field Day setup and operation in case people need to be talked in to the location, wherever it may be.

Gary reported that the Maple Methodist Church is not raising the rent for our meetings! **George K8GG** would like to use the church meeting room to conduct CW training. The tentative schedule is for Tuesday nights for 12 to 13 weeks. Each class would cost \$20 for rent. It was decided that the club would pay for one-half of the rent and all interested students would share the other half of the cost. The more students enrolled, the lower their cost. The real requirement is that all enrolled attend all classes.

Hamfest tickets will be available on 01/08/2013 and will be brought to the next general meeting so they can be purchased by club members. With the health problems that **Doc K8OLY** is facing, it seems that the club needs to find a member willing to take over the chair of the Hamfest committee. This will be a priority. Tom has been handling the incoming requests at present.

Tom announced that his wife has volunteered to work in the concession stand this year. Details of who will provide the concessions still need to be worked out.

It was also announced that the QRP Club will be using one of the MAC meeting rooms for their meeting, as has been done in the past.

It seems that **Terry KD8TCE** knows a person who can wrap the club trailers and this avenue will be pursued. The board feels that at least one of the trailers needs to have club identification applied before Field Day.

The meeting was adjourned at 6:15.




