Latest Technician class graduates 6!

February 22nd saw the end to another six week, 18 hour Technician-level class taught by Terry Tassos N8LN and Mike Russell KQ8N. Terry and Mike began the Gordon West WB6NOA based classes in 2013 after a need was seen locally for a class that offered more instruction and information than the Ham-in-a-day model. Mike and Terry became registered W5YI instructors, and moved forward with the class. They use powerpoint slides with illustrations that go over all 426 questions in the Technician pool, and also bring in many hands-on items such as radios, antennas, and metering devices. Students are encouraged to take practice tests on QRZ.com as well as read and review the Gordon West Technician Class Study Guide. The class is provided free of charge.

The sixth and final week of the class coincided with the SMARS VE testing later in the week. Five of the six students passed the Technician exam there. Congratulations to: Henry Hanna KE8DJQ, Josh Klavinski KE8DJS, Joel Laupp KE8DJR, Glenn Whitt KE8DJT, and Nick Smith KE8DJP (Nick also passed the General exam!). The sixth student, Wayne Campau KE8DHB, went to another test site a week and a half earlier due to a scheduling conflict, passing Technician and General. Congratulations to all of the students! There were several other prospective hams that had to drop out during the course of the class. It is hoped that they will continue to study for an upcoming exam or rejoin an upcoming class. Please make sure and welcome these new hams when you hear them on the radio. They will, no doubt, be nervous just as you were the first few times on the air. Encourage them to attend an upcoming SMARS meeting and put a face with your callsign.

An interesting side note to this class is that Mike and Terry now have seven hams in their familes, including themselves. Terry's sons are Josh KD8WRU and Jordan KD8TJP. Mike's son-in-law, newly licensed Nick Smith KE8DJP, joins son-in-law Brian KD8ZKI and Mike's wife Bev KA8HQN.
