No technical knowledge or Morse code requirements are needed. This class is for anyone who would like to obtain their **technician** or **general** level amateur radio license. People who have concentration issues or a learning disability may not do well in this type of class.

If you just want to take the test, show up at 4pm. You are allowed to take the Technician's, General, or Extra Test.
